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BARBER/BEAUTY SHOP PERSONNEL (HEALTH AND HYGIENE)		

POLICY: Offenders and staff will not perform barber/beauty shop duties when they may transmit infectious disease and/or ectoparasite infestation which could be transmitted to others while performing barbering/cosmetology duties.

PROCEDURES

- I. Offenders must be excluded from work in the barber/beauty shop if they have:
 - A. Ectoparasite infestation,
 - B. Skin lesions(s) or other potential sources of infection or infestation on body surfaces present on the barber/cosmetology inmate
 - C. Conjunctivitis
 - D. Disease which can be transmitted by the respiratory route.

- II. If an offender meets any of the exclusionary criteria listed in section I, he/she will require medical clearance to return to work. In such cases, licensed medical personnel will perform a screening and will record, if appropriate, the following phrase in the health record:

“Free of infectious disease and ectoparasite infestation in a form that can be transmitted to others while performing barbering/cosmetology duties.”
